Medication Assistants (MA-C) are specially trained to administer medications under the supervision of a licensed nurse. They can work in a variety of settings, such as long-term care facilities, home health, assisted living, and urgent care settings. Upon completing the course requirements, the MA-C is eligible to sit for the National (MACE) Certification Exam.

Who is eligible?

- Individuals knowledgeable of medical terminology
- Work-related experience/nursing home or hospital preferred

What are the Requirements?

- High school diploma/GED
- Valid driver's license
- Criminal/Consumer Background Check
- Good communication skills
- At least 17 years old
- Current CPR/BLS
- Pass a drug screening
- TB Skin Test
